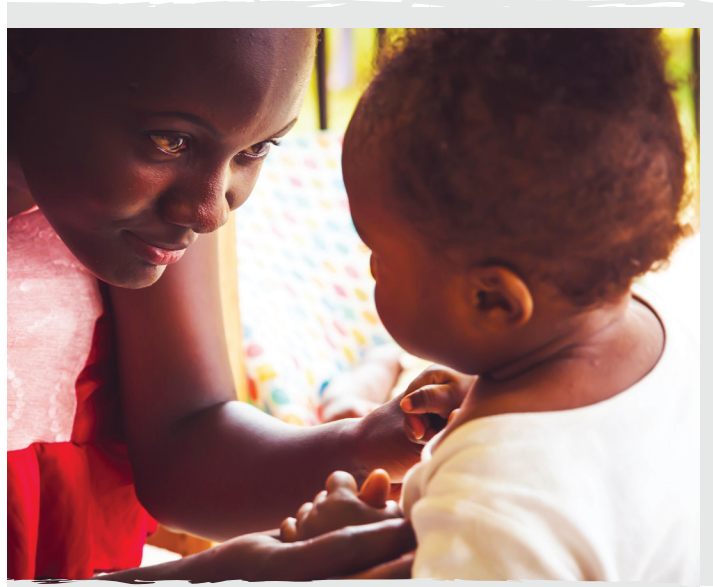

Every week in Uganda children are being abandoned and as a result are growing up in institutions.

At Ugandans Adopt, we believe that all children deserve to grow up in a loving family. Ugandans Adopt is working in partnership with the Ministry of Gender, Labour and Social Development to find Ugandan adoptive parents willing to provide loving and secure homes for abandoned children.

OUR PROMISE

Adopting a child is a lifelong commitment that will transform the life of both child and parent forever.

There are no golden rules as to what makes the perfect adoptive parent. If you have space in your heart to raise a child that is not your own, you could be just who we are looking for!

If you are thinking about opening your heart and home to an abandoned child, Ugandans Adopt will be with you every step of the way.

ADOPTION: 5 KEY FACTS

- You do not have to be rich to adopt a child. We charge no fee for adoption - all we ask is that you provide the child with a secure, loving home.
- You must be over 25 years of age and at least 21 years older than the child you wish to adopt.
- Both married and single people can adopt.
- Ugandan Law states that you must foster a child for 3 years before a formal adoption order is granted.
- Once a child is adopted, they become part of your family with full legal rights.

8 STEPS TO ADOPTION

1

EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

Contact the Ugandans Adopt team and we will send you an expression of interest form.

2

PREPARING TO ADOPT

Come along to one of our information days and hear other adoptive parents share their experiences.

3

ASSESSMENT

You will be assessed by a social worker. Assessment could take 3-6 months.

4

ATTENDING PANEL

You will be invited to attend a Government Panel to be approved as an adoptive parent.

5

MATCHING PROCESS

If approved, we will do our best to link you with a child that is available for adoption. Once a match is made, you will be given the child's background information.

6

MEETING YOUR CHILD

If you approve the match, introductions to your child can finally begin!

7

YOUR LIFE TOGETHER

You will enjoy watching your child grow and develop. The Ugandans Adopt team will continue to support you.

8

LEGALISING THE ADOPTION

A social worker will continue to support you through the three-year pre-adoptive fostering period, after which you undertake the legalisation process.
